Registration for Summer School opens on Monday, April 3, 2023, and will remain open until Friday, June 23, 2023.


#### IMPORTANT - PARKING LOT SAFETY! - Please read

Please be mindful of posted signs and avoid parking in the "no parking" drop off area. If you are dropping off your children, please go around to the drop off area (see BELOW), and then continue around the parking lot to exit. Please don't make u-turns at the entrance after you drop your children off.

Our front parking lot goes in a "one-way" direction. Please be mindful of students and staff who are trying to cross the parking lot to get to and from the school, as it is now dark in the mornings and it's hard to see people walking. If you are parking to come in with your children, please use the far west side of the front (south) parking lot to park, after the designated staff parking spots (there is no parking in the drop-off area). The back parking lot (where the buses come in), is closed to vehicles while the buses are there (arrival and dismissal times). Also be mindful of the handicap parking stall by the gate.

We would also like to remind our community that parking three vehicles deep in the visitor parking is a safety concern. Please do not block vehicles during pick up time.

# Student Absences

To ensure the safety of all of our students at Blueberry School, it is imperative that we are aware when they are absent from school. 
